What can you do???

- Do the children you watch spend much of their time crawling or playing on the floor?
- Do the children you watch often put their fingers and toys in their mouths?
- Was your home or apartment built before 1978?
- When the weather is nice outside, do the children play out in the yard?
- Has your home or apartment recently been remodeled or had a major renovation?



If you answer **YES** to one or more of the above questions, then you should know about the health risks associated with exposure to lead.
